

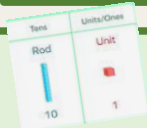


IPC

In our topic 'Super Humans' In Super Humans, we will be learning about how our bones, muscles, senses and nerves all connect to make us human. We will be investigating the ways in which these body parts interact with our brain, enabling us to see, hear, smell, taste and touch. We will be learning about the role of exercise in keeping healthy. We will be learning about how to keep healthy by learning about different food groups and the role they have in keeping us healthy. We will be applying this knowledge by explaining what we should include in a healthy meal or snack.

English

Through our Power of Reading text the children will be developing our understanding of descriptive language, rhythm and rhyme. We will be learning how poems are structured differently to fiction and non-fiction texts. The children will be performing poems and developing their drama skills by performing in front of an audience. They will develop their ability to sequence their writing by writing recounts of past events. The children will be encouraged to reflect on and edit their writing and consider word choice.



Maths

We will be developing our understanding of addition and subtraction using a range of written and practical resources and developing our understanding of how to use them to solve questions. We will be developing our understanding of more than and less than. We will be developing our understanding of using inverse operations to solve missing number questions. We will be developing our knowledge of number facts and number bonds and applying these to solve questions.
