

Numeracy

The focus this term will be on place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division. The children will learn how to represent 3 and 4-digit numbers in different ways and then how to compare, order and round numbers. They will learn how to add and subtract numbers using different methods and how to multiply using arrays. Yr3 will use 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times table facts and Yr4 tables up to 12 x 12. Children will also learn how to estimate and check answers.

PE

This term we will be learning about the sport of orienteering and will practise the skills involved in combining fitness with map-reading. Dance lessons will be related to our topics.

IPC

Our topic is *Temples, Tombs and Treasures* which will involve learning about life in Ancient Egypt and Ancient Sumer. In Art, we will be planning and creating our own tomb wall painting and making an Ancient Egyptian or Sumerian headdress. In Music, we will investigate Egyptian and Middle Eastern music and create a musical piece to recreate a story. Our science topic is electricity.
