Autumn 1 “Marvellous Me”



In **Personal, Social and Emotional Development (PSED)** we will be;

- Learning the names of our classmates and familiar adults and forming positive relationships.
- Noticing similarities and differences between others
- Learning rules and routines.
- Identifying our strengths and what makes us special and unique.

In **Literacy** we will be;

- Learning set 1 single letter sounds in phonics (hearing and saying sounds in words.)
- Learning to recognise and write our names independently.
- Practicing forming our letters.

In **Expressive Arts and Design (EAD)** we will be;

- Learning some routine songs.
- Exploring colours and colour mixing.
- Constructing with recycled materials.

In **Communication and Language (CL)** we will be;

- Learning the names of our classmates and familiar adults.
- Listening to and responding to stories.
- Talking in complete sentences using a range of tenses.

In **Physical Development (PD)** we will be;

- Developing our pencil grip and learning how to use small tools safely e.g. scissors.
- Jumping and landing with two feet.
- Running, demonstrating spatial awareness.
- Developing our throwing and catching skills.

In **Mathematics** we will be;

- Learning key times of the day, routines and where things go.
- Copying, continuing and creating repeating patterns.
- Learning some positional language.
- Ordering objects by size and weight.
- Matching and sorting.

In **Understanding the World (UW)** we will be;

- Naming and describing familiar people.
- Talking about our features and the things that make us unique.
- Describing the weather.
- Exploring the properties of different materials.
- Developing positive attitudes about the differences between people.
