## Maths

Areas to be covered:

Year 5: multiplication, division and fractions as well as arithmetic.

Year 6: the four operations, fractions and converting units (measurement). Arithmetic will also be ongoing.

## English

For Reading, the children will complete Shackleton's Journey and then look at Secrets of a Sun King by Emma Carroll, where we will cover a report, museum labels, an advertisement, balanced argument, a sports commentary and a discussion. In Writing, we will look at poetry, myths and legends first person narratives and balanced arguments.

## Space Scientists, Applied Art and the First World War.

In this unit, we will continue to learn about planet Earth, the planet we call home: its relationship with the Sun and Moon; what it is made of and how our understanding of the solar system has changed over time. Is Earth the best planet for human survival? Why? We will be scientists, historians, designers and artists to understand more about the planet where we live. For WW1, we will identify the reasons for historical events, place events into a chronological framework, write about aspects of the past from a range of sources, describe how the history of one country affects that of another, identify geographical patterns and to use their knowledge and understanding to explain them; use and interpret globes and maps in a variety of scales.
