- Showing resilience and perseverance when facing new challenges.

In **Literacy** we will be:

- Using punctuation accurately (full stops and capital letters)
- Developing comprehension skills (prediction and recall)
- Proof-reading our work to check it makes sense and editing where necessary.

In Mathematics we will be;

- Recapping composition of numbers including bonds of 5 and 10.
- Exploring odds and evens.
- · Using a number track to add and subtract.
- Solving mathematical problems.
- Exploring and comparing with cusienaire rods.
