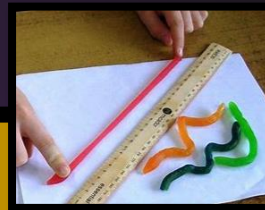

Maths

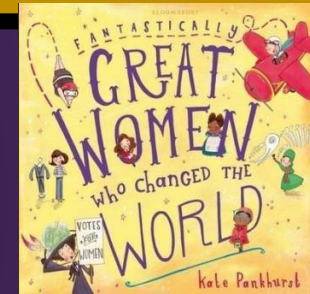
