IPC

This term our topic will be 'The Earth: our home we will be learning that all living things – plants, animals and people – have a home or somewhere to live that we call a 'habitat'. A habitat can be huge like the ocean or small like a leaf. To survive, living things need to live in places that meet their needs. What do living things need to survive? How do different habitats provide for their needs? We will need to be scientists and geographers in order to answer these questions.



Music
